Sample Schedule

June 7

Caesarea by the Sea, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Nazareth Precipice

June 9

Boat ride: Tiberias to Ginosar on Jesus Boat, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Afternoon Rafting on the Jordan River, Baptism in the Jordan River

June 10

Cross Sheik Hussein border, Leadership Lessons from the Centurion, Tour the Roman city of Jerash, visit King Hussein Mosque

June 11

Mt. Nebo Tour, The Leadership of Moses, Guided tours through Petra

June 12

Swim in the Dead Sea, Tour Masada and Qumran

June 13

Garden Tomb, Mount of Olives, Lion's Gate and St. Anne's Church, Pool of Bethesda, Via Dolorosa "Way of the Cross", Bethlehem

June 14

Jewish Quarter, Southern Steps, Rampart Walk from Dung Gate to Jaffa Gate, Visit to the Israel Museum, Depart for airport











General Info

Who is going:

SLU 401 is open for students who have completed SLU 301. Please note that all registrations are due by October 4, 2023. This allows us to achieve the best possible rates and fares.

Please know that this program has a waitlist every year. We will register you as soon as you turn in your deposit to guarantee your spot.

SLU encourages families and parents to travel together to their international trips. These trips are life transforming and are a wonderful way to build memories together as well as for you and your children to grow together in faith and in setting goals for the future. Parents who enroll in 401 must agree to abide by the same rules and schedule as all other 301 participants. Parents may not come to "part" of the SLU 401 experience, but they can enroll as full participants.

Travel information:

We will fly to Tel-Aviv. While in Israel we will travel by chartered bus and boat.

Cost:

The cost for SLU is estimated at \$5,000. This cost may change due to flight costs. A \$300 deposit is due at signup. This price includes all plane tickets, van travel, hotel, SLU fee, and meals. There are a few items not included in this price such as travel meals, snacks, driver tips and any souvenirs. It is recommended you bring \$120 per person for travel meals, driver tips, and snacks.

We understand this is an expensive trip. However we believe that SLU can be one of the most impactful experiences of a student's life. Therefore we are starting signups early so you have the opportunity to pay the trip out over the course of several months.

Cancellations:

- 120 days or more before: Deposit will be forfeited.
- 91-119 days before: 30% of program cost and 100% of flight cost will be forfeited.
- 61-90 days before: 50% of program cost and 100% of flight cost will be forfeited.
- 0-60 days before: 100% of cost will be forfeited.

Do I need a passport for SLU 301?

Everyone registered for SLU 401 will need a passport. The passport must be valid for six months after the completion of the trip. For how and where to apply, go to travel.state.gov/passport. You will need to submit your passport number 120 days prior to your trip.

How to register:

Every student who wishes to attend must register and pay the deposit online at concordonline.org/students. Applications are not needed for SLU 401.

In an effort to aid families with the cost of this trip, First Baptist Church has supplemented part of the cost of this trip. Because of this all registrations are due by October 4, 2023.
