
# **New York Mission Trip 2026**

# **General Info**

## Trip Overview:

We are partnering Chris White and local church planters. We will spend a majority of our time evangelizing and sharing the truth of Jesus.

#### Food:

We will be eating at our lodging site for breakfast daily. We will then carry packed lunches to our work sites. Dinner will be at the lodging site or in a restaurant.

# What Leaders Are Going?

Caleb Nichols and Chris White will be leading this trip. We will maintain a minimum ratio of 1 leader for every 8 students.

In addition parents are welcome to attend. Please note that due to the limited number of spaces on our trip we will give preference to students first.





# Lodging Info:

We will be staying at a hostel near Central Park. Rooming will be divided by gender and specific to our group.

### Travel Info:

We will drive to Atlanta and then fly to New York and use ground transportation while in the City.

#### Phones:

There will be times where students do not have access to their phones (at night, during Bible studies). Our leaders will have their phones at all times.

#### Money:

Meals while in New York are covered by the church. However we do estimate that students will need the following money while we are on the trip:

# **Important Notes**

## Requirements for Concord Students Missions:

Because a mission trip is an opportunity for us to serve others with the message of Jesus, it is a trip that requires more of those who attend. Therefore there are some basic requirements we ask of every student who is attending a Concord Students Mission Trip. Each of these requirements is designed to prepare students for their experience.

- Students must be actively involved in Bible Study Groups and Midweek, maintaining a 2/3rds attendance level.
- · Students must attend Beach Week.
- Students must attend all training sessions and parent and student information meetings. All meetings take place at the student building. Lunch is provided at 12:30 meetings.

#### Cost:

The cost of this trip is \$750. A \$200 non-refundable deposit is due to reserve your spot. This price includes all plane tickets, van travel, lodging, food, and fees. The only items not included in this price are travel meals, snacks, and any souvenirs.

We understand this is an expensive trip. However we believe that a mission trip can be one of the most impactful experiences of a student's life. Therefore we are starting signups early so you have the opportunity to pay the trip out over the course of several months.

Payment deadlines: \$200 deposit is due November 19 50% of balance is due December 12 Remainder of balance is due January 4 Please note all payments are non-refundable.

### How to register:
