General Info

Trip Overview:

We are partnering with UKA-USA ministries in Sunderland England alongside local pastors. This ministry has been active in the UK for many years and has seen thousands come to know Jesus.

Food:

We will be eating breakfast at our lodging site daily. Lunch will often be a packed meal. Dinner will either be at a host church or restaurant.

What Leaders Are Going?

A church staff member and UK-USA staff will be leading this trip. We will maintain a minimum ratio of 1 leader for every 8 students. In addition parents are welcome to attend. Please note that due to the limited number of spaces on our trip we will give preference to students first.

Lodging Info:

We will be staying in a hotel in the center of Sunderland.

Travel Info:

We will fly to London and travel to Sunderland by train. While in Sunderland we will use vans and ground transportation.

Phones:

There will be times where students do not have access to their phones (at night, during Bible studies). Our leaders will have their phones at all times.

Money:

Meals while in the UK are covered by the church. However we do estimate that students will need the following money while we are on the trip:

4 travel meals - \$100

Souvenirs - \$(depends on gender and shopping habits):)

- Toiletries (Towels! No towels are provided for the week)
- Clothing for 7 days. Dress for the week is casual. Please no tank tops.
- Pants for church on Sunday

- Sunscreen!
- Money (see above)

Important Notes

Requirements for Concord Students Missions:

Because a mission trip is an opportunity for us to serve others with the message of Jesus, it is a trip that requires more of those who attend. Therefore there are some basic requirements we ask of every student who is attending a Concord Students Mission Trip. Each of these requirements is designed to prepare students for their experience.

- Students must be actively involved in Bible Study Groups and Midweek, maintaining a 2/3rds attendance level.
- · Students must attend Beach Week.
- Students must attend all training sessions and parent and student information meetings. All meetings take place at the student building. Lunch is provided at 12:30 meetings.

Cost:

The cost of this trip is \$2125. A \$300 non-refundable deposit is due to reserve your spot. This price includes all plane tickets, van travel, lodging, food, and fees. The only items not included in this price are travel meals, snacks, and any souvenirs.

We understand this is an expensive trip. However we believe that a mission trip can be one of the most impactful experiences of a student's life. Therefore we are starting signups early so you have the opportunity to pay the trip out over the course of several months.

Payment deadlines:

\$300 deposit is due when registering by January 7

50% of balance is due February 1

Remainder of balance is due March 29.

Please note all payments are non-refundable.

If you need longer to make payments please speak to Student Ministry Staff Member ahead of time.

Important Dates:

Beach Week - June 22-27, 2025 - Cost \$635

How to register:

Every student who wishes to attend must register and pay the deposit by January 7, 2026. Applications and deposit payment link are available online at concordonline.org/students

In an effort to aid families with the cost of this trip, First Baptist Church has supplemented part of the cost of this trip. Because of this all registrations are due by January 7, 2026.
