General Info

Trip Overview:

We are partnering with Mission Lab at New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. Mission Lab has been proclaiming the gospel to the city of New Orleans for many years. While there students get to experience many different forms of ministry!

Food:

We will be eating breakfast and dinner at NOBTS every day. We will then carry packed lunches to our work sites.

Weather:

New Orleans in March is in the mid 60's to low 70's. It can also occasionally drop into colder weather or warmer weather.

What Leaders Are Going?

Harper Brady will be leading this trip alongside the Mission Lab team. We will maintain a minimum ratio of 1 leader for every 8 students.

In addition parents are welcome to attend. Please

note that due to the limited number of spaces on our trip we will give preference to students first.

Lodging Info:

We will be staying at the Mission Lab dorms on the NOBTS campus. Students will need to bring bedding or a sleeping bag. This facility is gated nightly.

Travel Info:

We will drive passenger vans to New Orleans.

Phones:

There will be times where students do not have access to their phones (at night, during Bible studies). Our leaders will have their phones at all times.







Money:

Meals while in New Orleans are covered by the church. However we do estimate that students will need the following money while we are on the trip:

4 travel meals - \$80

Souvenirs - \$(depends on gender and shopping habits):)

Requirements for Concord Students Missions:

Because a mission trip is an opportunity for us to serve others with the message of Jesus, it is a trip that requires more of those who attend. Therefore there are some basic requirements we ask of every student who is attending a Concord Students Mission Trip. Each of these requirements is designed to prepare students for their experience.

- Students must be actively involved in Bible Study Groups and Midweek, maintaining a 2/3rds attendance level.
- Students must attend Camp.
- Students must attend all training sessions and parent and student information meetings. All meetings take place at the student building. Lunch is provided at 12:30 meetings.

Cost:

The cost of this trip is \$500. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due to reserve your spot. This price includes van travel, lodging, food, and fees. The only items not included in this price are travel meals, snacks, and any souvenirs.

We believe that a mission trip can be one of the most impactful experiences of a student's life. Therefore we are starting signups early so you have the opportunity to pay the trip out over the course of several months. We are also offering the ability to make payments from October thru March that cover Mission Trip.

Payment deadlines: \$100 deposit is due November 19

50% of balance is due December 12

Remainder of balance of mission trip is due January 4

Please note all payments are non-refundable.

How to register:
